

HONORARY APPOINTMENTS CEDURE

1. Introduction

The University hain place a procedure for granting on orary titles, the purpose of which itso acknowledge a voluntary, unpaid contribution to a School's or the University's activities. procedure involves approval by the Senate on the recommendation of a Head of School, provided that some criteria are metand these are outlined below.

The responsibility for due diligence on nominees for the sepointments rests with the Head of School. Schools are required to submit a CValong with their nomination to Governance Services who will arrange for submission to Senate for approval. Honorary titles are normally awarded for period of between 1 and 3 years but can be extended to the request of the School.

Senate meets on four occasions during the year, and nominations can be submitted to each meeting. Nominations should be received by Governance Services at least 10 working days before the date of the Senate.

2. Criteria for Awarding an Honorary Appointment

The following are the criteria agreed by the Senate relation to the granting of honorary titles

- x No payment will be made for an individual's contribution
- x An individual awarded an Honorary titlewould not normally have access to the University's library or computing facilities However, this can be requested by the School
- x An individual awarded an Honorartitle is not entitled to office accommodation however, with the agreement of the School hay share such facilities as the School to provide
- x It is expected that individuals nominated for such roles will make a regular contribution the School and / or University. The contribution in this regard should bright icant.
- x By accepting an honorary title, the individual concerned will be required to agree to accept all rules, regulations and procedures of the University. Titles

- x Honorary Research Fellow/Senior Research Fellown respect of a major contribution to research

f)	The Senate reserves thright to withdraw anyhonorary title before the end of the agreed period if it considers that there is evidence of ncompliance with the terms of the contract or non-fulfillment of the agreed contributions the School and / or the University. The Senate's decision will be final.
